Regular giving

This can be monthly, quarterly or annually using Direct Debit. This is easy and quick to set up over the phone and is the most helpful gift, as regular income allows us to plan for the future.

Single gifts

Cash, cheque or a credit/debit card payment. We can take card payments securely over the phone and online.

Gifts in your Will

Gift Aid

A Gift Aid declaration can increase your donation by 28p for every pound. Higher rate taxpayers may also claim additional relief. This makes a tremendous difference to us – just £21.67 a month over three years will raise £1,000 with Gift Aid.

Shares

The donation of stocks and shares to charity are exempt in the UK from Capital Gains Tax so are therefore a very efficient and beneficial way to give. Simply contact the Foundation Director if you would like to give this way.

Tomorrow

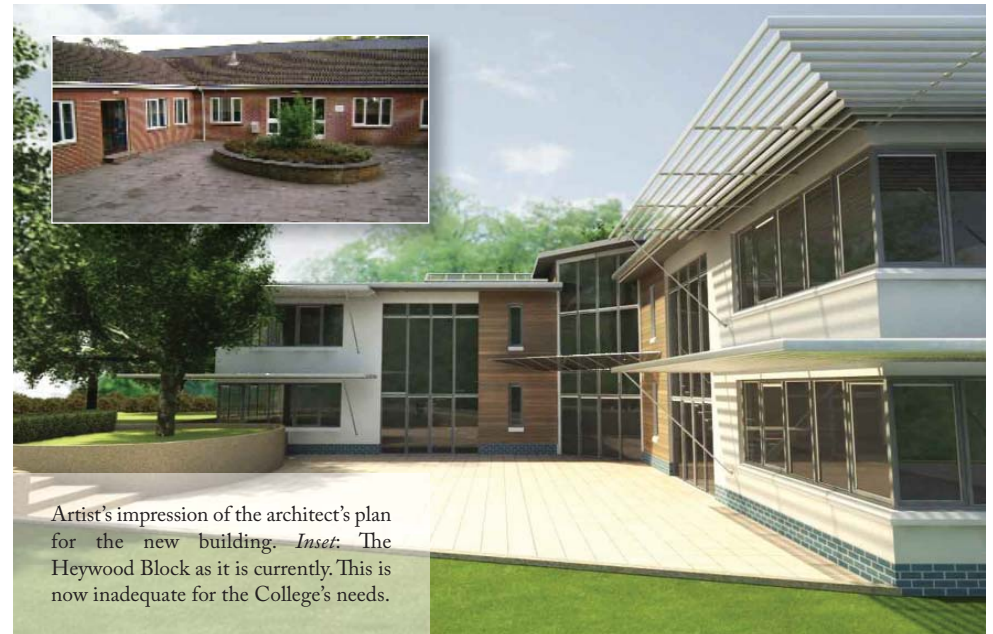
