Admissions Procedures

ENTRY AT SIXTH FORM

Candidates for Lower Sixth entry may be registered with the College at any point up to the closing date (usually the beginning of October in the year before entry). Once registered the Admissions Office will write to the candidate's parents to point to the next stage in the procedure, which is as follows:

The Year Before Entry

- Initial Enquiry* Visit to the school to meet an Admissions tutor and tour the school.
Registration – the current fee is £150, payable to Marlborough College.
- September* An open day specific to Lower Sixth entry is held for those entering the school the following year.
- Beginning of October* Closing date for registrations for the following September.
- November* Entrance examinations and interviews at Marlborough. We welcome applications from overseas students, who are also expected to attend for interview. Candidates who are applying for scholarships will sit the entrance exams. Successful academic applicants will be invited back the following week for the scholarship examinations.
- Early December* Places offered to successful candidates. Upon acceptance of a place confirmation fee of £1,000 is required.

The Year of Entry

- January/February* Completion of careers questionnaire.
Allocation of house places by the Senior Admissions Tutor.
- August* GCSE results sent to Marlborough.
- All candidates must achieve at least six grade Bs in their GCSEs including English and Mathematics (in practice, most successful candidates will get more GCSEs at considerably higher grades than these).
- September* Arrival at Marlborough.
