Admissions Procedures

ENTRY AT 16+ FOR SIXTH FORM

- Enquiry* Enquiries are welcomed at any stage. Prospectuses are sent along with further information relating to the Admissions Procedures.
- Registration* Candidates for Lower Sixth entry may be Registered with the College at any point up to the Closing Date (1st October the year before entry). The current non-returnable Registration fee is £250, payable to Marlborough College.
- Visiting the College* Lower Sixth visit events take place either towards the end of the summer term or the beginning of the Michaelmas term a year prior to entry. All who have indicated an interest will be sent an invitation to visit the College.
- October* Closing Date for Registration and Enrolment is 1st October a year prior to start of entry.
- November* Entrance Assessment and interviews take place at Marlborough early in November a year prior to entry. We welcome applications from overseas pupils, who are also expected to attend for assessment and interview. Candidates who are applying for an Academic Scholarship will have an additional Scholarship interview on their Assessment day.*
- December* Early in December places are offered to successful candidates and subject to final GCSE grades in the summer. Families have one week to either accept or decline an offered Place. Upon acceptance a confirmation deposit of £1,950 is required. Overseas residents are, in addition, required to pay a term's fees at this time and, if applicable, will be subject to a Tier 4 visa administration fee.
- January/February* Pupils with a Place at the College will be sent a careers questionnaire for completion. This questionnaire aims to help with A Level and Pre-U subject choices.
- June* The Lower Sixth Visit Day takes place mid-June. Pupils' proposed Sixth Form subject choices will have already been received and timetabled, however this event gives pupils a final opportunity to meet with Heads of Department to talk through their subjects and with the Guidance Department to discuss their careers questionnaires and tertiary education.
- August* GCSE results sent to Marlborough. All pupils with Places must achieve at least six grade Bs in their GCSEs including English and Mathematics (in practice, most successful pupils will get more GCSEs at considerably higher grades than these).
- September* Arrival at Marlborough College

* In order to apply for a music scholarship, a qualifying pre-audition is required prior to the candidate's Assessment day.
