Late Application for 13+ Entry

Late application procedures will be altered to align with new Admissions procedures commencing 13+ Entry in 2022.

Current Late Application Process for 13+ Entry in 2019, 2020 and 2021

For applicants who followed the Admissions Procedures and Assessment process, A List and B List place offers are made in March of Year 7. The deadline to accept or decline either type of place offer is towards the end of that Lent Term in Year 7. From the Summer Term of Year 7 late application enquiries can be made. The process includes the College taking contact details and requesting latest school reports to keep on file for reference. A strong candidate for a late place would be expected to make an outstanding contribution to the life of the College through his or her academic, sporting, artistic or musical talents. They might be a late developer whom a Head now particularly wishes to recommend, or a child who the Head believes will benefit particularly from being a member of a boarding community such as Marlborough College.

Should a late place become available the Director of Admissions would carefully consider late applications after children remaining on the B List. Suitable candidates would then be invited to complete and return a Registration form along with a Registration fee, currently £250, and arrangements would be made to visit the College for an assessment and interview.

An offer of a late place would be made to a successful candidate shortly after their visit to the College. If accepted, parents will be expected to nominate Marlborough as their only choice of school and to complete and return an Acceptance form along with a deposit of £1,950. Parents living outside the UK are required to pay an Additional Deposit of a term's fee, currently £12,605. For pupils coming to Marlborough from outside the EEA (European Economic Area) a Tier 4 Child Visa may be required and an administration fee of £250 should accompany the deposit. House places will be allocated as available in the College and with due regard to the balanced spread of talents throughout the community.

13+ Late Application Process for 2022 Entry onwards

From 2022 Entry, Marlborough is introducing new Admissions Procedures to allow three assessment points per entry year.

Year 6 Assessment: Approximately 70% of places for the Year 9 intake would be offered after Assessment at the College when they are in Year 6.

Year 7 Assessment: For families who come late to the process or who feel their child may not be quite ready to undertake the Assessment until they are a little older, there will also be a smaller Assessment point in Year 7 when approximately 25% of Year 9 places will be offered.

Year 8 Assessment: For Late Entry there will be an opportunity for applicants to sit an Assessment in Year 8 for approximately 5% of Year 9 places.
