Admissions Procedures

16+ SIXTH FORM ENTRY IN 2020

Enquiry	Enquiries are welcomed at any stage. Prospectuses are sent along with further information relating to the Admissions Procedures.
Registration	Candidates for Lower Sixth entry may be Registered with the College at any point up to the application closing date of 1 October 2019 . The current non-returnable Registration fee is £250, payable to Marlborough College.
College Visit	Lower Sixth visit events take place either towards the end of the Summer Term 2019 or the beginning of the Michaelmas Term 2019 , a year prior to entry. All who have indicated an interest will be sent an invitation to visit the College.
Scholarships & Bursaries	Scholarships and bursaries are available to apply for and further information can be found online: http://www.marlboroughcollege.org/admissions/scholarships-and-bursaries/ . All applications must be received by 1 September, 2019 (bursaries) and 1 October 2019 (scholarships)
Closing Date	The closing date for Registration and Enrolment is 1 October 2019 .
Assessment	Entrance Assessment and interviews take place at Marlborough early in November 2019 . The College welcomes applications from overseas pupils, who are also expected to attend for Assessment and interview.
Place Offers	Early in December 2019 , College Places are offered to successful candidates. These are subject to final GCSE grades meeting the minimum requirement of six grade 6s or equivalent. House Places are allocated, although the College will take into consideration strong preferences where possible. Families have one week to either accept or decline an offered College Place. Upon acceptance a confirmation deposit of £1,950 is required. Overseas residents are additionally required to pay a term's fees at this time and, if applicable, will be subject to a Tier 4 visa administration fee.
Guidance	Pupils with a College Place will have the option to complete a careers questionnaire which aims to help with A Level and Pre-U subject choices.
Visit Day	The Lower Sixth Visit Day takes place in June 2020 , three months prior to arrival. Pupils' proposed Sixth Form subject choices will have already been received and timetabled, however this event is a final opportunity to meet with Heads of Department to talk through their subjects and with the Guidance Department to discuss tertiary education and career options.
GCSE Results	GCSE results are to be sent to Marlborough College on receipt. All pupils with College Places must achieve at least six grade 6s in their GCSEs or equivalent including English and Mathematics. In practice, most successful pupils achieve grades considerably higher than this.
September 2020	Arrival at Marlborough College.
